Ms. Jody Gauthier stated the audit proposal represented a 10% increase over last year's fee. Gauthier said the increase was due to the additional GASB 68 fee of \$3,500. Gauthier explained with GASB 68 additional audit procedures are required. Alderman Esposito asked if this is a new charge for this year. Gauthier replied it is a new charge for this year, but it will be a requirement going forward. Gauthier said the charge may not be as high next year. Administrator Marrero said BKD, formerly Wolf, have been the City's auditors for many years and she looks forward to working with them this year. 2. <u>Status Report Payout Number Two (2): FBG Corporation For The City Hall Renovations.</u>

Mayor Ragucci said demolition, framing, drywall, and painting portions of the remodel are complete. Assistant to the Mayor and Administrator Sarallo updated the Council on the status of the City Hall renovation project. Assistant to the Mayor and Administrator Sarallo said the bathroom has been enclosed and the electrical work will begin this week with cabling and tiling next week. Assistant to the Mayor and Administrator Sarallo said the project is moving along quickly at this point and he will be meeting with the contractor tomorrow to discuss Phase 2 of the project. Assistant to the Mayor and Administrator Sarallo said Phase 2 encompasses where the current reception area and discussions are underway as to where the public will be routed in the interim. Alderman Greco said the renovations look great. Alderman Greco suggested a better information center be created to display pamphlets and brochures. Mayor Ragucci said staff will look into this. Alderman Thomas asked the timeframe for completion. Assistant to the Mayor and Administrator Sarallo replied early September.
