1. Draft Ordinance Approving And Authorizing The Publication Of A Revised Official Zoning District Map For The City Of Oakbrook Terrace, Illinois

The Illinois Municipal Code requires the corporate authorities of a municipality to publish the municipality's zoning map on an annual basis, no later than March 31st (65 ILCS 5/11-13-19). The published zoning map should include all zoning changes from the preceding year. If there were no changes to the zoning map in the preceding year, then publication is not required.

As a result of the recent annexation of 1S140 Myrtle Avenue, there were changes to the official map this year. During the annual review of our map there were a few other items that were updated. A summary of the changes can be found below:

- Annexation of 1S140 Myrtle Avenue
- Modified how Lincoln Avenue, Royce Boulevard and Renaissance Boulevard are shown to make it clear that sections of those roads are not public right-of-way.
- There were three lots along Wayside Drive that were not shown within the City's municipal boundaries.

Recommended Action: If the amended Zoning Map is acceptable to the City Council, an ordinance to the subsequent Consent Agenda for consideration.

1. President Pro Tempore Greco reminded City Council about the resident Easter Event being held on March 23rd at Stella Mae Swartz School from 12:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m.
2. President Pro Tempore Greco reminded the City Council that the first FY24-25 Budget Meeting will be on Wednesday, March 13, 2024, in Council Chambers starting at 6:00 p.m.

XI. COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE CONSIDERATIONS

1. **Draft Ordinance Amending The Provisions Of Title XI (Business Regulations); Chapter 124 (Video Gaming); Subchapter 124.22 (Number Of Licenses) Of The Code Of Oakbrook Terrace To Increase The Maximum Number Of Video Gaming Location Licenses And The Maximum Number Of Video Gaming Terminal Licenses (7-Eleven):**

President Pro-Tempore Greco asked the City Council to review the draft ordinance increasing the gaming licenses by one (1) to 7-Eleven. He stated that the Class "E" Liquor License was obtained in July 2022, and they have received all necessary permits.

Owner Rehan Hashmi spoke to the City Council about adding video gaming to his establishment. He explained his process of applying for the gaming license, the gaming area, hours of operation, and the pour license. Mr. Hashmi stated that he is not adding the gaming to create a more significant profit but to supplement income due to increased costs with his business.

Alderman Rada asked for clarification on the frosting of the class that would keep patrons from viewing inside, and Mr. Hashmi stated that some areas of the glass will be clear so the

attendants can see in. Alderman Beckwith asked for clarification on the delay in coming before City Council for the gaming license and for further clarification on the pour hours. Alderman Barbari asked if the pour hours and gaming license times could be adjusted. Alderwoman Fitzgerald agreed with the comments of Alderman Beckwith about the application delays while stating that area is already saturated with gaming establishments which causes concern. Alderman Greco indicated that he has always had concerns about additional gaming licenses within the city.

3. **Consideration Of Passing A Resolution In Support For A Community Free Of Racism, Hatred, And Bigotry In All Forms:**

President Pro-Tempore Greco said this resolution was asked to be placed on the Committee of the Whole for consideration to be passed by the City Council.

Alderman Rada provided further information regarding the proposed resolution. He described an incident that spurred Glen Ellyn into passing the resolution. Alderman Rada was not sure if the resolution would do anything but wanted to make the statement that the City of Oakbrook Terrace would not tolerate any acts of racism, hatred, and bigotry.

XII. COUNCIL MEMBER COMMENTS

Alderman Fitzgerald gave an update on the Public Notice received from Aqua Water regarding increased water per usage and surcharge rates. She said the increase would raise her water bill by \$30. Alderman Fitzgerald stated that the City of Elmhurst is looking to invest in its water infrastructure and is putting together a capital improvement infrastructure for about \$17.8 million. She said she participated in a Zoom call with Northern Illinois University regarding updates on the Strategic and Comprehensive Plan and was very pleased with the updated information that she received.

Alderman Beckwith discussed Governor Pritzker’s proposal of removing the 1% grocery tax, and how this will impact local municipalities with revenue losses, and how this is another unfunded mandate. He also discussed if the City of Oakbrook Terrace would be interested in hosting a community blood drive.

Alderman Rada discussed the grocery tax increase and how Villa Park is now scrambling to become a home rule community because of this. He described his frustration with Aqua Water services and how our State Representative is working hard to assist everyone with this water issue. He also informed the City Council that hotels are almost at pre-COVID occupancy numbers and that events being hosted in surrounding communities have increased occupancy in our Oakbrook Terrace hotels.

City Administrator Ritz informed everyone about the resident-only Easter Event being held on March 23rd at Stella Mae Swartz school and some of the events taking place for the kids. City Administrator Ritz discussed how repealing the 1% grocery tax will affect the City of Oakbrook Terrace and local municipalities, and that he sent a copy of a letter in opposition of elimination of this tax to the City Council. He then provided updates to the City Council about the PulsePoint program, and that the final storm sewer project payment was sent out and we will be receiving the final grant payment award for the project. He also recognized the excellent job by the Oakbrook Terrace Police Department Investigations Unit for their work with several other agencies in solving one of our burglary investigations.

ORDINANCE NO. 24 - 11

AN ORDINANCE DECREASING THE NUMBER OF CLASS “E” LIQUOR LICENSES BY ONE (1), PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF TITLE XI (BUSINESS REGULATIONS); CHAPTER 111 (FOOD AND BEVERAGES); SUBCHAPTER ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR CONTROL, SECTION 111.012 (NUMBER OF LICENSES IN EACH LICENSE CLASSIFICATION), OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF OAKBROOK TERRACE, ILLINOIS, AS AMENDED (LAKHANY OAKBROOK TERRACE, LLC D/B/A STAYBRIDGE SUITES)

WHEREAS, the City of Oakbrook Terrace (the “City”) is a home-rule unit of local government under Article VII, Section 6 of the 1970 Illinois Constitution and, except as limited by such Section, it may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs;

WHEREAS, Section 111.018 of the Code of Oakbrook Terrace, Illinois (the “City Code”) provides that any licensee who has ceased to do business or closes its place of business for a period of more than 30 successive days, without written permission therefor from the Liquor Commissioner, shall be subject to having its license declared forfeited or lapsed by order of the Liquor Commissioner;

WHEREAS, Lakhany Oakbrook Terrace, LLC doing business as Staybridge Suites, 200 Royce Blvd., Oakbrook Terrace, Illinois (the “Licensee”) has ceased to do business or closed its place of business for a period of more than 30 successive days without written permission therefor from the Liquor Commissioner, and is subject to having its license declared forfeited or lapsed by order of the Liquor Commissioner pursuant to Section 111.018 of the City Code;

WHEREAS, the Liquor Commissioner has ordered the Licensee’s Class “E” liquor license forfeited and has notified the City Council of the forfeiture of the Licensee’s license, a copy of which Order is attached hereto, marked as Exhibit “A” and made a part hereof;

WHEREAS, Section 111.012 of the City Code provides that the total number of liquor licenses may be increased or decreased from time to time, by the adoption of an ordinance amending the City Code, in the discretion of the City Council upon failure of the Licensee to renew its liquor license, or upon notice from the Liquor Commissioner that a liquor license has been declared forfeited or lapsed pursuant to section 111.018 of the City Code, or that a liquor license has been revoked by order of the Liquor Commissioner pursuant to Section 111.037 of the City Code; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that it is necessary to decrease the number of Class “E” liquor licenses that authorize the retail sale of alcoholic liquors for consumption only on the licensed premises, including restaurants, cocktail lounges, and hotels due to the forfeiture or lapse of the Licensee’s license;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Oakbrook Terrace, DuPage County, Illinois as follows:

Section 1: The recitals set forth above are incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 2: Pursuant to Section 111.012 (Number of Licenses in Each License Classification) of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Oakbrook Terrace, the number of Class “E” liquor licenses to be issued in the City is hereby decreased by one (1), decreasing the total number of Class “E” liquor licenses to be issued in the City to twelve (12).

Section 3: Title XI (Business Regulations), Chapter 111 (Food and Beverages), Subchapter Alcoholic Liquor Control, Section 111.012 (Number of Licenses in Each License Classification), of the City’s Code of Ordinances is hereby amended to read as follows:

§ 111.012 NUMBER OF LICENSES IN EACH LICENSE CLASSIFICATION.

(A) The total number of liquor licenses of all classes (except Class C) issued under this subchapter shall not exceed the sum of all classes, and as further restricted to the following totals by classes:

- (1) The total number of Class A licenses shall not exceed twenty-one.
- (2) The total number of Class B licenses shall not exceed five.
- (3) The total number of Class C licenses shall be limited pursuant to § 111.009(C).
- (4) The total number of Class D licenses shall not exceed zero.
- (5) The total number of Class E licenses shall not exceed twelve.
- (6) The total number of Class F licenses shall not exceed one.
- (7) The total number of Class H licenses shall not exceed zero.
- (8) The total number of Class I licenses shall not exceed one.
- (9) The total number of Class J licenses shall not exceed one.
- (10) The total number of Class K licenses shall not exceed zero.
- (11) The total number of Class L licenses shall not exceed two.
- (12) The total number of Class N licenses shall not exceed zero.
- (13) The total number of Class O licenses shall not exceed zero.
- (14) The total number of Class P licenses shall not exceed zero.
- (15) The total number of Class Q licenses shall not exceed zero.

(B) The total number of licenses may be increased or decreased from time to time, by the adoption of an ordinance amending this code, in the discretion of the City Council as follows:

- (1) Pursuant to § 111.007(B), upon the recommendation of the Commissioner concerning an applied-for license of a particular classification;
- (2) Upon failure of a licensee to renew its license, or upon notice from the Commissioner that a license has been declared forfeited or lapsed pursuant to §

111.018 of this subchapter, or that a license has been revoked by order of the Commissioner pursuant to § 111.037 of this subchapter.

Section 4: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict.

Section 5: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage, approval, and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.

REQUEST:

Mayor and City Council to review the ordinance prepared by the City Attorney.

BACKGROUND:

The Illinois Municipal Code requires the corporate authorities of a municipality to publish the municipality's zoning map on an annual basis, no later than March 31st (65 ILCS 5/11-13-19). The published zoning map should include all zoning changes from the preceding year. If there were no changes to the zoning map in the preceding year, then publication is not required.

As a result of the recent annexation of 1S140 Myrtle Avenue, there were changes to the official map this year. During the annual review of our map there were a few other items that were updated. A summary of the changes can be found below:

- Annexation of 1S140 Myrtle Avenue
- Modified how Lincoln Avenue, Royce Boulevard and Renaissance Boulevard are shown to make it clear that sections of those roads are not public right-of-way.
- There were three lots along Wayside Drive that were not shown within the City's municipal boundaries.

**AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE PUBLICATION OF A
REVISED OFFICIAL ZONING DISTRICT MAP FOR THE
CITY OF OAKBROOK TERRACE, ILLINOIS**

WHEREAS, the City of Oakbrook Terrace (the “City”) is a home-rule unit of local government under Article VII, Section 6 of the 1970 Illinois Constitution and, except as limited by such Section, it may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Division 13 of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 Illinois Compiled Statutes 5/11-13-1, *et seq.*), and pursuant to the applicable provisions of Title XV, Chapter 156 entitled “Zoning” of the Code of Oakbrook Terrace, Illinois, the City Council of the City has heretofore adopted the Zoning District Map of the City of Oakbrook Terrace, Illinois, delineating the location and boundaries of the districts established by Chapter 156;

WHEREAS, pursuant Section 11-13-19 of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/11-13-19), the corporate authorities of the City are required to cause to be published the official Zoning District Map no later than March 31st each year showing the existing zoning uses, divisions, restrictions, regulations and classifications of the City for the previous calendar year; and

WHEREAS, the Zoning District Map attached hereto as Exhibit “A” and made a part hereof, is the official Zoning District Map of the City, inclusive of changes from the preceding calendar year, showing the existing zoning uses, divisions, restrictions, regulations and classifications of the City for the preceding calendar year;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Oakbrook Terrace, DuPage County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1: The facts and statements contained in the preambles to this ordinance are found to be true and correct and are hereby adopted as part of this ordinance.

Section 2: The corporate authorities of the City of Oakbrook Terrace hereby adopt the Zoning District Map attached hereto as Exhibit “A” and made a part hereof, as the official Zoning District Map of the City which shall be on file in the office of the Zoning Administrator. Copies of the official Zoning District Map of the City shall be available to the public for reference at all times during which City Hall is open and may be certified on request.

Section 3: The City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to publish the Zoning District Map in pamphlet form in accordance with the requirements of Section 11-13-19 of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/11-13-19).

Section 4: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict.

Section 5: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
