VI. PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

Al Rago, a Trustee of York Township Board, described the hardship the food pantry is experiencing due to the government shutdown creating a significant increase in activity for the 130 residents they serve.

Bruce Aldermoth from the Lions Club addressed council revealing that his church feeds approximately 140 homeless people breakfast every Saturday. Most recently, they had over 200 people in attendance. The Lions Club is bringing back Someone Special. On 4/18, they will host a play, *The True Story of the Three Little Pigs* at Willowbrook HS put on by Alphabet Soup.

X. MAYOR ESPOSITO

The City of Oakbrook Terrace along with the Villa Park VFW had a tremendous turnout for the Veterans Day Ceremony. Mayor Esposito acknowledged and thanked our Veterans. Alderman and Veteran, Greco was thanked for his speech at the ceremony.

Aqua Illinois is merging with the American Water Company in 2027. No further details at this time.

There was a discussion in regard to supporting the York Township Food Pantry. The Mayor proposes a donation of \$10,000 under 501c and to be put on the next consent agenda.

The Lions Club is having their annual Christmas Tree sale. The cost is \$50 for a tree and \$60 for a tree and stake. The City will purchase 15 trees and any resident in need of a tree is able to receive one. Delivery for the trees is scheduled for 11/29.

XI. COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE

1. An Ordinance for the Levying, Assessment and Collection of Taxes in the Amount of \$1,142,159 for the Fiscal Year Beginning May 1, 2025 and Ending April 30, (correction) 2026 for the City of Oakbrook Terrace, DuPage County, Illinois.

Foster & Foster recommends a 2.9% property tax increase over last year's 3.4% bringing this year's requested levy of \$1,142,158.82 or an increase of \$32,177.29. In previous years, the City was short in paying the police pension. In 2023, it was short by \$4,966, 2024 \$310,709 and in 2025 \$174,0000. Alderman Biskup mentioned that the police pension is well funded at 76%. The Mayor added that it is well ahead of other communities.

Preparation of a tax levy ordinance for the 12/9 was moved to the consent agenda. Additionally, Ms. Walker added that the SSA will be falling off and will also be added to the 12/9 consent agenda.

2. Development Update – Melissa Headley

Ms. Headley went over the most recent permit activity and development updates. Council asked several follow-up questions.

- 3. Resolution Designating the City Council Meeting Schedule for The City of Oakbrook Terrace, Illinois.
 - The 2026 Regular City Council Meeting dates were reviewed and moved to the consent agenda.
- 4. Arbitrator Opinion and Award In the Matter of the Arbitration between the City of Oakbrook Terrace, Illinois and the Metropolitan Alliance of Police, Victoria Johnson, Grievant FMCS Case No. 240313-04382.

The Mayor introduced Attorney Yvette Heintzelman, from the Office of Clark Hill representing the City of Oakbrook Terrace. Council received a copy of the arbitrator's opinion and award. The Mayor thanked both City Attorneys, Richard Ramello and Yvette Heintzelman for their time and in working in the best interest of the City. The case dates

back to 2015 when the City repeatedly disciplined Victoria Johnson. She was terminated on two separate occasions in 2022 and in 2024. Ms. Johnson filed numerous complaints of discrimination, retaliation, harassment and bullying against the police chief and the deputy chief. The arbitrator stated Victoria Johnson repeatedly lied with untruthful information and did so intentionally to disobey her supervisors and superiors. The Mayor is pleased for the win for the City but saddened for the police department and the distress this caused.

Attorney Yvette stated the arbitrator found in favor of the City and that Ms. Johnson's grievance was denied and her complaints were not made in good faith and not accurate. Adding that the police chief and deputy chief did not engage in the alleged conduct. The decision vindicates both the police chief and deputy chief.

Alderwoman Fitzgerald questioned why the results of arbitration were being discussed in an open meeting. The Mayor responded that on 2/25, Victoria Johnson's grievance along with the Vote of No Confidence was brought to the attention of council during her public comment within an open meeting. Therefore, the arbitrator findings are being shared within an open meeting.

Alderman Sarallo stated that the report speaks for itself and was a costly venture for the City.

Alderman Biskup had no comment.

Alderman Greco was pleased that the results were shared in an open meeting.

Alderman Rada had no comment.

XII. COUNCIL MEMBER COMMENTS

Alderwoman Fitzgerald was happy to be at the Veterans Day ceremony and complemented the Mayor and Alderman Greco for their speeches. She thanked Willowbrook HS for singing at the ceremony.

Alderman Sarallo thanked the Veterans for their service.

Alderman Barbari expressed his thanks to the veterans. He questioned whether the City will donate toward the Salvation Army fundraiser. The Mayor suggested Alderman Barbari work with City Administrator, Walker.

Alderman Biskup attended the Veterans Day ceremony and said it was great to see all the Veterans.

Alderman Greco proud to see many residents and staff at the Veterans Day assembly.

Alderman Rada relayed that speed cameras are back up on Meyers Road and noticed that traffic slows down when they are up. The DuPage Visitors Convention Bureau is working on alternate financing.

We are approaching the renewal period for the City's Property, Casualty, and Workers' Compensation insurance coverage. We have received updated quotes and pricing from our insurance broker, Marsh McLennan Agency.

Marsh McLennan Agency continues to serve as the City's broker for risk management services, and we believe they consistently prioritize the City's best interests in securing coverage. The proposed insurance package provides comprehensive protection, including general liability, automobile, property, equipment, law enforcement, crime, workers' compensation, cyber (privacy), and extended coverage. All current policies are scheduled to expire on December 31, 2025.

The Workers' Compensation renewal reflects a 3.5% decrease, or \$6,616, from last year. This reduction is primarily due to decreased payroll exposure and fewer injury claims.

The Illinois Public Risk Fund (IPRF), one of the state's largest workers' compensation carriers and our long-standing provider, has allocated a 2026 Safety Grant of \$31,947 to the City of Oakbrook Terrace.

The Cyber Liability renewal came in at an increase of \$44 (.52%) over expiring premium. However, a change in carriers to Houston Casualty Company is recommended, resulting in significant savings—46%, or \$3,910—along with a reduced deductible (\$5,000 compared to \$10,000).

The Storage Tank Pollution Liability renewal increased by 10%, or \$213, due to the aging of the tanks and the associated higher risk of failure and claims. It is recommended that the tanks be replaced before reaching 20 years of service.

Our review of the materials submitted by Marsh McLennan Agency indicates a 0.40% increase, or \$1,473, in the 2026 renewal for Risk Management Services.

Obsidian Specialty is offering an alternative to the Travelers renewal, resulting in savings of 9.07%, or \$33,642. This new program—developed by Marsh McLennan Agency earlier this year for municipal clients in Illinois—provides the City with substantial cost savings as well as a two-year rate guarantee. Therefore, we recommend selecting Obsidian as the City's Property and Casualty insurance carrier due to the advantageous terms and cost savings it provides.

Executive Summary

We appreciate the opportunity to present this proposal to you.

Our proposal was developed with your specific insurance and risk management needs in mind. If additional information is needed for you to facilitate your decision-making process, please let us know.

The overall renewal with your incumbent carriers resulted in an increase of 0.40% or \$1,473. This is attributable to our marketing efforts as Travelers was originally going to offer a renewal with a 10-15% increase but came down in pricing after learning of the alternative option being offered. Obsidian Specialty is offering an alternative option from Travelers for a savings of 9.07% or \$33,642 from the renewal with Travelers. Obsidian Specialty is a new program that MMA developed this year to offer to our municipal clients in the state of Illinois, and affords the city a large savings, as well as a 2-year rate guarantee.

The workers' compensation renewal is down by 3.5% or \$6,616 from last year, which is largely attributable to the decrease in payroll exposure. IPRF is offering a safety grant in the amount of \$31,947 for the 2026 policy year.

The cyber liability renewal came in at an increase of \$44 (.52%) over expiring, however, we are recommending a change to a new carrier (Houston Casualty Company) for significant savings in premium (46% / \$3,910) as well as a lower deductible (\$5,000 vs \$10,000).

The storage tank pollution renewal is up by 10% / \$213 over the prior year. We will continue to see slight increases in cost as the tanks continue to age; the older they become, the more likely there is to be failure of the tanks which would result in a claim. We recommend replacing storage tanks before they reach 20 years of age, at which point your terms and pricing would become far more restrictive.

ORDINANCE NO. 25 - 36

AN ORDINANCE RETIRING AND DISSOLVING SPECIAL SERVICE AREA NUMBER TWO IN THE CITY OF OAKBROOK TERRACE, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, the City of Oakbrook Terrace, Illinois (the "City") is a home-rule unit of local government under Article VII, Section 6, of the 1970 Illinois Constitution and, except as limited by such section, it may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs;

WHEREAS, on June 28, 2005, the City Council, pursuant to Section 7(6) of Article VII of the Constitution of the State of Illinois, the Special Service Area Tax Act (35 ILCS 200/27-5, et seq.), and the Local Government Debt Reform Act (30 ILCS 350/1, et seq.), adopted Ordinance No. 05-09 entitled *An Ordinance Establishing a Special Service Area in the City of Oakbrook Terrace (Special Service Area Number 2)* establishing Special Service Area Number Two consisting of the property legally described in the attached "Exhibit A - Legal Description", which the ordinance was recorded with the DuPage County Recorder of Deeds recorded on August 15, 2005 as Document Number R2005-175716 and re-recorded on August 26, 2005 as Document Number R2005-186137;

WHEREAS, the stated purpose of the establishment of Special Service Area Number Two was to provide special municipal services to the geographical area covered by Special Service Area Number Two including certain improvements to the City's water system and to levy a tax within Special Service Area Number Two for a period not to exceed twenty (20) years;

WHEREAS, the special municipal services to the geographical area covered by Special Service Area Number Two have been completed and all of the bonds issued for payment of said special municipal services rendered to Special Service Area Number Two have been fully retired;

WHEREAS, no property tax levy has been or will be submitted to the DuPage County Clerk for Special Service Area Number Two for the fiscal year beginning May 1, 2025 and ending April 30, 2026, the taxes for which are collected by DuPage County in calendar year 2026;

WHEREAS, the DuPage County Clerk has requested that, due to the fact that no tax has been or will be levied on Special Service Area Number Two for the fiscal year beginning May 1, 2025 and ending April 30, 2026, the taxing district known as Special Service Area Number Two be retired or terminated; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the City to retire and dissolve Special Service Area Number Two and to terminate the authorization of the levy of taxes in the Special Service Area Number Two.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Oakbrook Terrace, DuPage County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1: The facts and statements contained in the preamble to this ordinance are found to be true and correct and are hereby adopted as part of this ordinance.

Section 2: That the City's Special Service Area Number Two is hereby retired and dissolved effective for the fiscal year beginning May 1, 2025 and future years. No further special service area taxes shall be levied in Special Service Area Number Two for the fiscal year beginning May 1, 2025, the taxes for which are collected by DuPage County in calendar year 2026, and for future years.

Section 3: The City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to send a certified copy of this ordinance to the DuPage County Clerk on or before December 31, 2025.

<u>Section 4</u>: If any provision of this ordinance, or the application of any provision of this ordinance, is held unconstitutional or otherwise invalid, such occurrence shall not affect other provisions of this ordinance, or their application, that can be given effect without the unconstitutional or invalid provision or its application. Each unconstitutional or invalid provision or application of such provision is severable, unless otherwise provided by ordinance.

Section 5: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict.

Section 6: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its date of passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as required by law.
