York Township Services Continue During COVID-19 Crisis

York Township Supervisor John W. Valle announces that due to COVID -19 concerns, essential township services, such as Meals on Wheels, food pantry distribution with expanded hours and senior transportation for essential rides will continue. The Township will continue to keep all other offices closed to the public until Tuesday, April 7th, as per the Governor.

FOOD PANTRY DAYS AND TIMES

Monday through Friday with new hours.

8:00 am to 9:00 am is reserved for **special needs** and **senior residents 60 and over** “**ONLY**”.

9:00 am to 11:00 am is reserved for **all eligible residents**.

Door side pick-up.

Accommodations will be made for our **seniors, special needs, and disabled residents** with unique hardships who cannot make it to the food pantry during pantry hours. Any York Township eligible resident who needs assistance with food will be helped.

Our caseworkers are working remotely for general and emergency assistance, and general inquiries will be handled by telephone or email. Please visit www.yorktwsp.com or call **630-620-2400** for more information.

Supervisor Valle stated, “We will continue to serve those who are most vulnerable during this unprecedented time. While our doors will be closed to the public to help curtail the spread of COVID-19, we will not abandon our residents, especially those in need of food. Township staff are here to answer any questions or concerns. We are committed to delivering needed assistance and will continue to do so through alternative methods in order to keep our staff and community safe and healthy. We are all in this crisis together and together we will get through this.”
